As I write this the Administration building which served as our first sanctuary has been removed and transported to El Paso Texas. We received \$9,000.00 for that building. Ed's building, after more than 20 inquiries could not be sold, or even given away, because of transportation challenges, has been torn down and the site cleared for the beginning of construction today June 11th, 2019.

It struck me as I walked around these two buildings, before they were removed, how much love and care they had received through the years. The landscaping was beautiful and the buildings themselves well maintained. Truly, they were showing their years and wear and tear, but the only reason they were able to serve our church so long was the tender care they received. I also heard many stories of when they first arrived and the worship services and classes in these two buildings. I heard how volunteers remodeled them, painted them and more. I thought of all these things as the buildings were empty and ready to go and it was a bittersweet time, which I think many felt. The new was coming but the old had to go.

The Landscaping Crew did a lot more than landscaping with these two buildings and Sunday we said thanks for all they did but I want to say it once more, "THANKS". You did good work and in honor of the landscapers and their work, a couple in the church donated the \$11,189.00 needed to complete all of the landscaping for the new building. They wish for their identities to remain a secret, but their thanks for the hard work and love the Landscapers be known. Now with all the new landscaping you will even have more to do (3).

Last Sunday it was shared that there was still a need for \$\$\$ for three items: The Front Entrance Canopy, the Nursery Remodel, the full landscaping scope We are so happy to announce that the entire amount for landscaping has been received! God is so good!

The two remaining items that still need funding are:

- 1. The Front Entrance Canopy \$36,660
- 2. The Nursery Remodel \$34,890

Please continue to keep these items in your prayers as we move forward with the construction of our new administration/education building.

From The Building Committee

Needs - Our Congregation must to come up with \$37,000 in new pledges and donations by 1 October to build an entrance canopy for the New Vistas Building. If a group of people would team up and pool your resources it could be more quickly, easily and effectively achieved. We hope that seeing the physical progress of constructing the New Vistas building excites you as much as it does us and that *"the spirit moves you"* to support our wonderful church.

Status - The demolition phase is complete and the construction phase has begun. SAFETY FIRST - We anticipate having earth moving equipment on-site for quite some time and do ask that you be aware of your surroundings at all time and that you do not enter the fenced construction area without first visiting the on-site project superintendent. You will NEED closed toe shoes, a hard hat and a reflective vest as well as his prior personal permission to enter the fenced construction area – SAFETY FIRST - is much more than a slogan.

You will probably see concrete poured during July and then a steel frame and girders raised as in the hymn Onward Christian Soldiers we march onward towards ribbon cutting in December.
