Notes "Order in the Church" Matthew 18:15-20

All of the below is to be undergirded in prayer.

Jesus' First Step: "A Private Matter" August 29th, Sermon. Speak to the person privately.

Three rules on a better way to deal with church hurt and practice reconciliation.

- 1st, Healthy- speak to the person privately.Unhealthy- Raise a posse, or petition, or bring the matter up first in front of others.
- 2nd, Healthy- attack the problem and not the person.

 Unhealthy- attack the person, their character and call names.
- 3rd, Healthy- speak the truth in love, **privately!** Unhealthy- evil speculation, gossip.

Jesus' Second Step: "A Semi-Private Matter" September 12 sermon. Approach the person with a 3rd party or 2 or 3 mediators. Many times a single "ambassador" works best.

Three more rules on a better way to deal with church hurt and practice reconciliation.

- 4th, Healthy- seek reconciliation and understanding. Unhealthy- grow a "root of bitterness"
- 5th, Healthy- forgive "Love keeps no record of wrongs". 1 Cor. 13:5 Unhealthy- condemn
- 6th, Healthy- agree to disagree Unhealthy- whip up opposition

Jesus' Third Step: "A Public Matter" September 19 sermon. When the issues go to the "Official Boards"

7th, Healthy- Knowledge. Make sure you truly hear and understand. 7 possible messages: What you mean to say, what you say, what the other person hears, what the other person thinks he hears, what the other person says about what you said, and

what you think the other person said about what you said. And finally, "They haven't heard you at all!"

Unhealthy- speculative accusation

- 8th, Healthy- forgive and forget Unhealthy- "forgive" and not forget ie. Count the sins
- 9th, Healthy- deal with issues as they come up

Unhealthy- save up hurts in a "big sand bag" and when it is full and you are mad beat the person with all of them at once.
