## **Pastor's Pen**

In my July 24<sup>th</sup> Sermon I mentioned that it is time for Vista Church to capture a new vision to move it forward in the next year and even several years. Our last major vision was building the new Education and Administration building. From beginning to end it was a 5-year project. But...as soon as the building was built and dedicated, we went into lockdown due to Covid the effects of which are still being felt. For two years we were in simply a survival mode that only this year are we achieving anything like "normal". It's a "new normal" though, because so much has changed. The campus footprint has changed. We have new offices, classrooms, and workrooms and a new lobby that has gone almost unused because of Covid. Sadly, what has changed most is that we have lost so many folks to death and moving "to be back near the children". During the years of Covid we lost 28 to death and since then about a half a dozen more. I believe we need to regroup and repurpose to move forward. We need a new vision.

Jeremiah 29:11-13 gives us guidance in our situation. "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."

In prayer and discussion, we need to seek God's direction for us. We need to revive that which worked for Vista Church before "Covid", and we must seek God's new vision for us. I encourage all our members and friends to be in prayer seeking God's vision for our church. Our Church Council will be meeting August 16<sup>th</sup> for an extended period of time to calendar out the next year, dream about our future together, and seek God's plan for us. In the meantime, share with one of our Council Members or email the church if you have something God has laid on your heart.

I believe the Spirit of Christ gathers with us when we gather in his name. So, I look forward to hearing from you and Jesus when we gather on August 16<sup>th</sup>.

## **Mission Outreach Ministry July/August 2022**

#### Dear Vista Family:

As I write this report, I find it almost impossible that Fall is just a month away. It has been a hot but productive summer and I want to share with you some of the highlights of the past 2 months.

1)Fuente de Vida, our sister church in Agua Prieta, Mexico, received 138 sponsorships for a current total of \$4503.00 contributed by the Vista Church family. A big thank you goes to Jan Hopke-Almer, Robin Conner & Peggy Smith for their great job again this year. It is no small task, getting all the student's names, grades, sponsors, finances and all the record keeping each year as we carry out this economic advancement program for our sister church. This annual effort has paid out in so many advancements in the life of these students and their families.

2) We will start collecting sign ups from folks who will be going with us on Saturday, Oct 29<sup>th</sup> to Agua Prieta to participate in the Celebration of Learning Festival. We hope to fill the 50-passenger bus. We will have some folks from the Sun Lakes Methodist Church that will be joining us also. For a number of years, the Sun Lakes church has supported the tuition for all our High School students from Fuente de Vida. We have been unable to hold the festival for the last 2 years due to Covid restrictions, but that has been lifted and once again we will be able to meet our sponsored child and have a day of great fun. Please check your passports to make sure they are current so you can join us on the 29<sup>th</sup> of Oct.

3) This past week we delivered 72 backpacks & school supplies to Family First and had the fun of watching the kids pick out their favorite backpack. We will be adding another 30 backpacks this next week as the need has continued to increase up the Copper Trail. There was a very nice write up and pictures of the event in the San Manuel Miner newspaper about the back packs that were given out. We also received a lovely thank you note from Frank &n Clare Grochocki director of Family First. "Dear Dee & Vista Mission:

So glad you could be with us to give out the backpacks. You must have been as surprised as us to see so many children who came to receive them. Thank you so much for the Vista Mission Group donating the backpacks full of school supplies. We are so grateful. What a blessing Vista is to Family First. God bless you.

4) This past week there was a headline in the Arizona Daily Star stating that "rent in Pima County has gone up 57% since 2021". This has been really hard for many families who have to buy food and pay rent for their families with the increase in food cost. We need to help our local families with our support for Impact's Foodbank. We will be collecting your donations both in food goods and checks, made out to Vista UMC and "Food bank" in the memo line on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Aug. the 7<sup>th</sup>. Thank you in advance for your generous support for our community.

5) Vista Mission Outreach Ministry has not met this summer, but has still been busy, we will resume our meetings in September, on Wed. the 14<sup>th</sup>at 1:30 PM in the ST. Matthew room. All are welcome to attend as this is your Mission Program.

I am asking you to help me pray that God will send us a new Chairperson to lead the Mission Committee in the coming year 2023. ## August 2022 Finance Committee Report

June Income was \$349 under budget. Year-to-date we are \$315 over budget and \$31,782 less than last year. Expenses plus mortgage payment were \$459 over budget for June and \$2,310 under budget year-to-date. Expenses are \$4,163 less than last year. General Fund Net Income after our mortgage payment was - \$13,065, which was \$808 under budget. June expenses were \$13,065 more than income because June is a low income month and we paid our semi-annual insurance payment of \$5,857.

Through the first half of the year, we are very close to our income and expense budgets.

We now owe \$302,482 on our mortgage!!!! We estimate that the mortgage principal at the end of July will be \$299,500. If you would like to donate to the Mortgage Reduction Fund, please click the Donate link on our website to charge a gift, or write a check to Vista and indicate Mortgage Reduction on the Memo line.

Our 2020 audit was completed by Jim Galka. There were no significant findings to be addressed.

The Finance Committee will not meet again until August, when we will begin our Stewardship Campaign and budget process planning.

We have used it for many years. You can donate to the General Fund or the Mortgage Reduction Fund.

#### Cash Giving Through Your Bank and Investment Accounts

<u>Automatic Clearing House - ACH</u> Another option is to set up an ACH transfer between your bank and the church's bank. Contact our Assistant Financial Secretary Mary Berg.

<u>Bank Bill Pay</u> You can set up paying a gift directly to Vista through your bank. Contact your banker for further information. (The church uses this method for all reoccurring monthly bills.)

<u>IRA Gift From Your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)</u> from their IRA to a charity such as Vista UMC and it can count towards your RMD (Required Minimum Distribution).
