On Tuesday, July 26, 2022 Myron Boyd (Buddy) Carpenter Jr. passed away at the age of 82.

Boyd was born on September 19, 1939 in Dallas to Lera and M. Boyd Carpenter Sr. After earning his undergraduate degree from the University of Arizona in 1961, Boyd became a lifetime Arizona Wildcat fan. He joined the United States Air Force in 1962, relocated to Southern California, and transferred his duties to the California National Air Guard in 1970. He later obtained his MBA from UCLA in 1972. On March 10, 1973, he married Karon Kay Carpenter. They settled in Simi Valley, California and raised two sons, Mark and Kurt.

Having earned his pilot's license at the earliest age possible, Boyd embarked on a life of carefully planned adventure, from the Marshall Islands to Germany, France, South Pacific to Panama, and all the way back to Tucson, AZ. He enjoyed the experiences and the people he met. He could always narrate stories from the past with accurate dates, locations, individuals, and even the weather at the time.

Boyd's heart and passion was spent with his loving wife of 49-years. Avid Sunday service attendees, Boyd and Karon found joy and community in the Methodist faith. Never content with mere collection-plate donations; Boyd dedicated his time and expertise to the church, contributing to the improvements and developments of the church experience for others.

Boyd joins his father M. Boyd Sr., his mother Lera, and his brother, Gary. He is survived by his wife Karon, his two children, Mark and Kurt, his daughters-in-law Amber and Molly and his grandchildren Maddox and Maverick.
