## Pastor's Pen—March 9, 2023

Dear members and friends of Vista Church,

#### THE STARFISH

A story is told of a little girl walking down the beach at low tide. As the tide went our it stranded 1000s of starfish on the beach. As the girl walked she would pick up one starfish after another and toss it back into the ocean. Her friend who was walking with her looked up and down the beach with the 1000s of stranded starfish that were slowly dying in the sun. It seemed they were lined up for miles. The friend then said to the little girl as she was about to pitch another starfish into the ocean, "What does it matter. There's so many of them." The little girl replied "It matters to this one as she tossed it back into the water."

My last look at the numbers of Ukrainians that have fled the Russian invasion of their country was 4 million. 1.5 million of those who have fled are children. It seems like throwing starfish back at low tide helping any of them, but we as a church are in the process of helping three. Their names are Maksym (the dad), Kateryna (the wife) and Oleksandra (the 18 year old daughter who fled the second semester of her freshman year). Sometime in the next several months, these three will arrive and we will help them get a new start in life, arriving with just a couple of suitcases. Some indeed in our congregation know what it is to flee a war torn country for the safety of America. I asked for volunteers to step up last Sunday and 35 people stepped forward. Do we know exactly what we are going to do? No. Will it be expensive and time-consuming? I think so but I believe when we stand before the Judgement seat of Jesus we will hear these words: "Well done good and faithful servants for I was a stranger and you welcomed me!"

Watch the bulletin for more opportunities to help and give to support this family's new start in America. The Mission Committee is sponsoring this and has set up an account to receive donations. Last year our congregation gave over \$18,000.00 to help in Ukraine. We are going to need about \$3000.00 for the first three months of their arrival. They want to come to America and work and they are already researching jobs here in the Tucson area. They want to be productive, contributing members of our society, because they are probably never going home. Their hometown was shelled and occupied the first day of the Russian invasion and it is still under occupation. No last names will be given for they still have relatives in that area in Ukraine.

Thank you all for joining in this journey of faith!



## **Finance**

## March 2023 Finance Committee Report

January 2023 Financial Results: We exceeded our revenue budget by \$2,342 but income was \$14,921 less than last year. Prepaid pledges were \$18,400 vs. \$23,087 in 2022. Expenses plus mortgage payments were \$340 under budget, resulting in a General Fund Net Income that is \$2,682 over budget but \$15,159 less than last year.

January Facebook and In-person attendance increased in 2023. We do not have Boxcast attendance yet.

Mortgage: As of December we owed \$283,039 on our mortgage!!!! As of December 31, we have received \$45,054 or 100.1% of our \$45,000 Lenten Challenge. If you would like to donate to the Mortgage Reduction Fund, please click the Donate link on our website to charge a gift, or write a check to Vista and indicate Mortgage Reduction on the Memo line.

As of January 31, we owe \$234,169 on the Mortgage. Our generous donor made their gift in January.

**Stewardship Campaign**: As of January 31, 2023 we have 130 pledges for \$358,094, which is \$22,130 less than last year. The average pledge is \$2,7556 vs \$2,832 in 2022. In 2022 we had 136 pledges for \$385,200.

<u>Audits</u>: Dan Boring completed the 2021 Audit. His recommendation is to have two team members who serve in alternating years so that one member will have experience. Dan also recommended an Assistant Treasurer for Succession planning, since all of the knowledge of practices and procedures resides with only the Finance Chair and Treasurer. Additionally, he recommended that when only one counter is available, the deposit should wait until two persons are available. This only occurs during very slow times. There were no procedural recommendations. All of his recommendations have been completed. Anne Hilton was elected Assistant Finance Officer/Treasurer at the February 14, 2023 Church Council meeting and both began the 2022 Audit in February, 2023.

The choir is always looking for new members. Show up in the Elizabeth Room on Wednesdays at 1:00 or speak to Jane Anderson after church.




