<u>Vista United Methodist Church Welcomes Pastor Mary Dotson!</u>

Vista de la Montana United Methodist Church is looking forward to welcoming our new Pastor, Rev. Mary Dotson. For the past four years, Pastor Dotson has been the been assigned to the Green Valley United Methodist Church in Henderson, Nevada and prior to that, she served the First United Methodist Church, in Safford, Arizona. Pastor Mary was raised in a family of pastors, with her father, grandfather, great-grandfather and several uncles all serving in the Mennonite, Church of the Brethren. Although she believed that she was being called to the ministry, that denomination that did not permit women to serve as pastors, so after graduating from college, she taught English as a second language in Tokyo, Japan.

Pastor Mary has said that it wasn't until her two children were in high school, that she again was called to ordained ministry and attended the American Baptist Seminary in Philadelphia. While completing a yearlong internship with a large Methodist Church she became a member of the United Methodist Church and began the process of completing her ordination.

Mary's husband, Ash Dotson had a career working with the U. S. Air Force as a guidance systems analyst and later worked as a test engineer on rocket and satellite motors before he was called to the ministry. He was then licensed and appointed as an associate pastor while completing seminary and later served four different appointments in the east. Most recently, he has been serving the Page Community United Methodist Church near Las, Vegas, Nevada and has now been appointed to serve the Methodist Church in Eloy, Arizona.

Desert Southwest Conference District Superintendent Matt Ashley has described Pastor Mary as "a gifted pastoral leader, preacher, and administrator" and a caring listener who will build strong relationships with people throughout the congregation". Clearly, we are all pleased to have Pastor Mary appointed to serve at Vista de la Montana and welcome all in our community to join us as she leads us in our walk with Christ.

Along with principal spots in the American Youth Philharmonic, Devin studied and performed chamber music at the Levine School of Music, where he had the opportunity to work alongside guest artists such as Itzhak Perlman and Leon Fleisher. Attending Cincinnati Conservatory of Music on scholarship, Mr. Gardner went on to further obtain degrees with full tuition scholarships from George Mason University and the University of Arizona. Devin currently maintains a private piano and oboe studio and serves as an accompanist for the woodwind department at the UofA. He is especially fond of modern French flute repertoire, with Dutilleux, Bozza, and Jolivet being some of his favorite composers. In addition, Mr. Gardner performs throughout Arizona and Texas with the Arizona Opera, Sierra Vista Symphony, El Paso Symphony, and St. Philips in the Hills. Living in the scenic Foothills with his two beautiful dogs Venkman and Zeddemore-named after two of his favorite Ghostbusters-he is also an avid participant in bowling, pool, and darts, and enjoys walking with his dogs all over Oro Valley and Marana.
